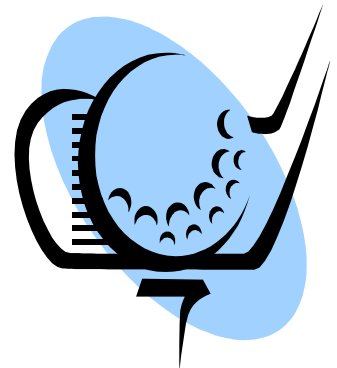

Friday Night Meals

If your child is under the age of 12 and wants to be on the putting green or driving range, he/she is required to have parental supervision. This is for their own safety. Also, please remind your children not to run or climb on the furniture in the clubhouse. We want to make the atmosphere pleasant for all people attending every event.

HANDICAP/RULES APRIL-MAY 2011 from darrell pierce

To promote junior golf in Iowa, the Iowa Golf Association will again offer free-of-charge IGA membership and provide a handicap for our junior members. They presently have to be age 17 and under, but applies even if they reach age 18 during this golf season. Todd, Megan or I will need the junior member's name, month, date and year of birth so it can be entered into the database by May 17th.

Please remember for those just establishing a Handicap Index, you must post at least five 18-hole scores. Once you have posted 20 scores, your Index is calculated using your 10 *best scores*, relative to the Course Rating and Slope Rating. It is important to note that your Index is based on your *peak* performance, not your *average* performance. Thus, a golfer whose average score is 12 over the Course Rating (at Oneota: $68.7 + 12 = 80.7$ white tees) you will have an Index in the neighborhood of 9.

Your Handicap Index takes your 20 most recent scores, factors in Course Rating and Slope Rating, arrives at a number that includes a decimal point and is calculated out to the tenths place. As such, your Index might be 3.8, 13.2, or 24.5, etc. Your Index is adjusted on a regular basis, usually once every two weeks when golf is "in season" in your part of the country. (In other words, if you live in Arizona or Florida, you receive a new Index every two weeks year-round. If you live in Minnesota, Wisconsin or Iowa, you receive a new Index every two weeks from April 1 to October 13.)

Wednesday the 13th, a golf friend asked me how long one could wait while his ball overhangs the hole. Rule 16-2 states, "When any part of the ball overhangs the lip of the hole, the player is allowed enough time to reach the *hole* without unreasonable delay **and an additional ten (10) seconds** to determine whether the ball is at rest. If by then the ball has not fallen into the hole, it is deemed to be at rest. If the ball subsequently falls into the hole, the player is deemed to have hole out with his last stroke and must add a penalty stroke to his score for the hole." You'll probably recall that in this situation you don't see PGA players run to the hole; they tend to do a bit of ambling to their ball while it rests on the precipice.

Speaking of the ball resting on the **edge**, there are two other situations where this is critical: 1. A ball is on the putting green when any part of the ball touches the putting green; 2. A ball is *out of bounds* when all of it lies *out of bounds*. Note: A player may stand out of bounds to play a ball lying within bounds.

You can post your scores online and print a handicap card.. Just use any browser for Iowa Golf Association and click on Your Handicap and the drop-down, Post a Score. Use your seven-digit GHIN number. (This is not your club number.)

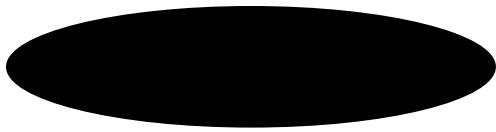
